Most of our patients come from Herefordshire itself, but as these hospitals are close to the county borders, we also care for people who do not live in Herefordshire.

No days are ever the same for our multi-disciplinary teams who care for patients either following transfers from Hereford County Hospital, or direct admissions to the community hospital, and staff work closely with patients and relatives to support them as they get ready to go home.

We are justifiably proud of the healthcare services we offer local people - all our community hospitals perform well and regularly receive high ratings in the recently-introduced Friends and Family Test.
